## Third Grade Reading Ohio Achievement Assessment

Third grade students will be taking their fall Ohio Achievement Assessment (OAA) in Reading on Tuesday, October 7th.

This is not a test that will require students to study prior to taking. Their teachers have reviewed reading skills and strategies since the beginning of the year. Teachers have also provided practice questions

so that students will be familiar with the test format.

#### GIFTED AND ENRICHMENT SERVICES

Barberton City Schools provide gifted intervention services to identified students in grades 3 and 4.

Mrs. Bruzda, the Gifted Intervention Specialist, works closely with classroom teachers to plan enrichment projects and activities both in the SEARCH room and the

classroom. She also provides Teacher Based Teams in grades k- 2 support services and assistance with high ability students. teacher based teams meet weekly and look at student achievement and instructional methods for all students.

Often Mrs. Bruzda will work with groups of students

who have shown mastery on grade level skills. She uses strategies to increase the complexity of a process, product or the content of what is being covered in the classroom. Look for enrichment activities that come home on purple paper.

You do not need to have one every year. Volunteers may file a background check at the Barberton City Schools Administration Building every Tuesday from 9:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. and Thursdays from 1:30 p.m. until 3:30 p.m. through October 31.
