By 2020, all students K-12 will demonstrate at least one year growth annually on state and/or district approved assessments and earn at least 70 AMO points in each subgroup on the building and district report cards.

BCSD will implement and monitor student growth through the implementation of the 5-step process with fidelity, feedback loops between teachers and students, meta-cognitive strategies, and other high yield research strategies endorsed by the DLT.

- The DLT has chosen feedback as the high yield strategy to focus on during the 2015-2016 & 2016-2017 school year.
- Implements, monitors, and evaluates actions that BLT does to help progress towards the goals
