It's time for our annual school fundraiser!

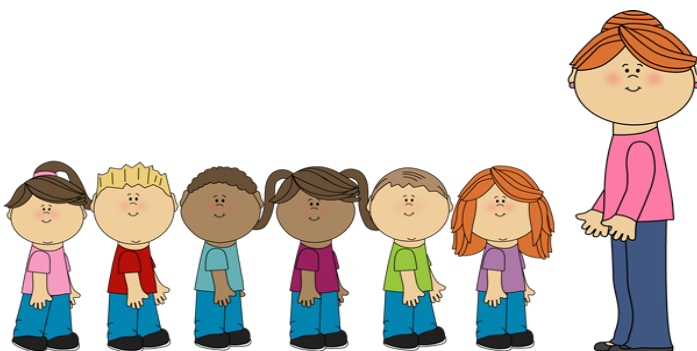
This year, we have a different selection from you to choose from. There will be food items, cookie dough, Cinnabons, tumblers and more!

Daily Attendance

Don't forget to practice math facts at home!

It's the middle of the school year! Check to see if your student is where they should be with their math facts!!

Kindergarten students should be able to count to 100.

First and second grade students should know their 0-5 addition and subtraction facts.

Third and fourth grade students should know their 0-20 addition and subtraction facts PLUS their multiplication and division facts.



Friendly Reminders!

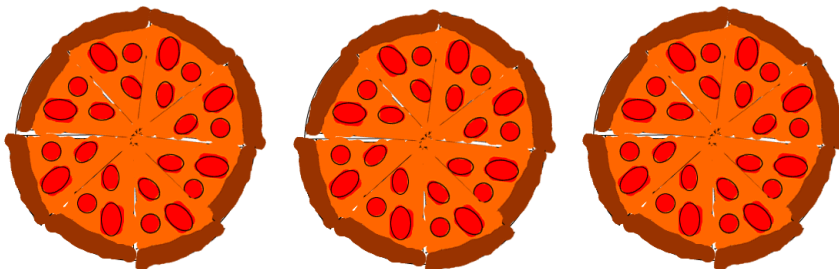

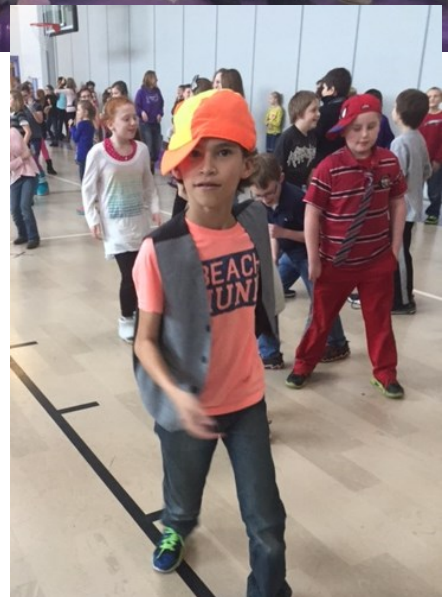
