A donation truck will be parked at BHS on **Saturday, May 13, 2017 from 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.** (rain or shine) and will be located in the BHS parking lot located off of Barber Road (near the Band Room doors).

BHS will be compensated based on the number of bags/pounds of cloth goods collected. **We will earn 20 cents/pound from those types of cloth donations listed above.** Even stained or torn items can be recycled into something else.
