You probably have made a few, maybe even broken a few already! The new year is also a good time to sit down with our kids and reflect on their educational progress. Here are a few suggestions to talk to your student and even reflect as a parent.

It's good to start with asking your child what they see for themselves. You may suggest a few broad categories for them to think about such as personal, friendships, helping others and education.

Continue to ask questions of your student after their school day. Instead of simply asking how was your day, considering asking...

"What was the best thing that happened at school today?"

"How were you kind or helpful to someone today? Was someone kind or helpful to you?"

Students will always have homework!! Do not let them tell you different! While some teachers may send home a math page to do, students are expected to read for 20 minutes each night and practice math facts. The only way we get better is by practicing! Do you have a designated time for students to do their homework? *Is there a designated* area in the home for students to do their homework?



Encourage your students to set goals for themselves at school. With their parents working together with the teacher, students can do it! They can set goals to improve mastery of math facts or improve in their reading level. Accomplishing goals at school will give students a sense of pride.



It is encouraged that families support our positive school expectations—Be Responsible, Be Respectful and Be Ready to Learn. This not only reinforces the expectations at school but could help around the house too! Always notice when they do a good job and let them know. Remind them that every day is a new day. 
Students are not outside long, but it doesn't take long for them to get cold when not dressed appropriately!
