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Avoid the summer slide...

This is typically due to not practicing their skills over the summer. Here are a few, simple things you can do to help avoid the *summer slide*:

- Read something everyday. Read the newspaper or magazines, read signs or schedules while traveling.
- Practice math facts. Get flashcards at the dollar store or make them from summer packets. Practice 10 minutes everyday!
- Join the Barberton Public Library summer reading program...and then actually do it!!
- Set a goal to read a certain number of books this sum mer. The goal should be based on the age level of your student.
- Complete summer homework packet. Students will bring home reading and math activities at the end of the school year.
