Each grade level also has classroom vocabulary. You can access activities to support these words at the Magic Vocabulary site on the school webpage.

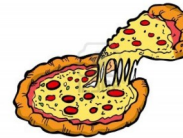

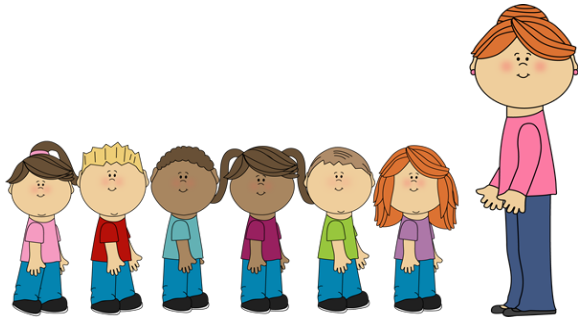

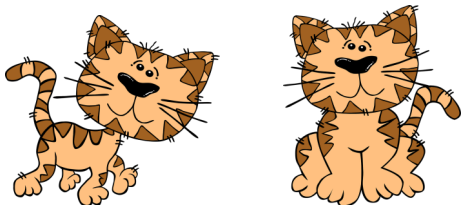
