Third Grade Fall Testing

Third graders will be completing their Fall English/Language Arts AIR tests on Tuesday, October 22nd and Wednesday, October 23rd. It is essential that all third graders are present on those days. In the case of an emergency/illness, that forces any third grader to miss one of those days, they will have the opportunity on Thursday or Friday to make-up the part of the test they missed. Third grade students will be going to the Barberton Magical Theater for a show on Friday, October 25th. Keep in mind that any student who misses either part of the AIR test due to attendance will not be able to attend the Barberton Magical Theater as they will need to remain at school to complete their tests. Fall scores can be used for the third grade reading guarantee however the purpose of our fall tests is to get a baseline score which helps our third grade teachers guide instruction and meet students needs in reading and writing. **We ask that our BEE third grade families promote with your student taking their time and trying their best!**
