3rd Grade AIR Testing

Third graders will be completing their Fall English/Language Arts AIR test on Tuesday, October 20th and Wednesday, October 21st. It is essential that all third graders are present on those days. In the case of an emergency/illness, that forces any third grader to miss one of those days, they will have the opportunity on Thursday or Friday to make-up the part of the test they missed. AIR tests are completed on the student's Chromebooks and therefore students **MUST** bring their **FULLY CHARGED** Chromebook with them to school on their testing days. **In-person learners** will complete this test in their homerooms with their teacher.

Remote learners will report to the school building on these days for testing as well and will complete the test in the cafeteria. Remote learners will need to bring their **FULLY** charged Chromebook with them as well. All safety protocols will be followed, masks must be worn to enter the building, and students will be appropriately distanced while taking the test. Remote learners will test at their home school (BEE students will test here at East). Students should be dropped off in the back loop off of 2nd Street (behind the gym) beginning at 9:45am. A staff member will be out to greet your student and escort them to the cafeteria. The test will begin at approximately 10:00am. Students will be picked up in the same loop after the completion of the test between 11:30am-12:00pm.

Please make sure your student gets a good night's rest the evening before testing and encourage them to try their best!
