

- PM Arrive Quebec City Airport / Collect luggage - Meet Uniropa Tour Director and transfer to your hotel
- 12:30 PM Arrive **Quebec Hotel** - Check in and welcome orientation (*bellman handle luggage*).

Québec City, founded in 1608 is the birthplace of French North America. It is also a UNESCO world heritage site and the only walled city north of Mexico.

- 5:30 PM Dinner at authentic French Canadian restaurant in Old Québec – **INCL**
- PM Enjoy a ride on the ferry that connects Québec City to Lévis, a city directly across the St. Lawrence R.
The view of Québec City and the surrounding area is breathtaking from the ferry
- 10:30 PM Curfew each evening at hotel (*chaperone to advise exact time*)

- 8:30 AM** Full Québécois breakfast at authentic restaurant in Old Québec – **INCL**
- 10:00 AM** Visit and tour the *Martello Tower* “Soldier of the Tower” - Interactive activity on the Plains of Abraham where you will actively partake in defending the city as a soldier posted. Through this exercise, you will quickly understand first-hand the importance of a soldier’s responsibility and the living conditions of a soldier in the early 1800’s
- 12:30 PM** Personal exploration and lunch in Old Quebec - Place Royale / Rue du Trésor / Quartier Petit Champlain
- 2:30 PM** Visit and Tour *La Citadelle de Québec*, an active military garrison. Often referred to as the “Gibraltar of North America”, this huge star shaped fort is built high on a cliff above the St. Laurence River
- 5:30 PM** Dinner at authentic French Canadian restaurant in Old Québec – **INCL**
- 7:30 PM** Enjoy a unique *Snowshoeing* adventure by “lantern light” on the Plains of Abraham
- 10:30 PM** Curfew each evening at hotel (*chaperone to advise exact time*)

- 8:30 AM** Enjoy breakfast in the Québec Parliament Building at *Le Parlementaire* – **INCL**
- 9:30 AM** After breakfast enjoy a tour Quebec's *Parliament Buildings* – The seat of Quebec's provincial government
- 11:00 AM** Depart your hotel by private coach for tour of the beautiful **Beaupre Coast** – You will visit Ste Anne de Beaupré Cathedral and pilgrimage site, Montmorency Falls (*100 feet higher than Niagara Falls*), Copper Shoppe, and a traditional Québécois Sugar Shack
- 3:00 PM** Continue along the Beaupre Coast for *Ile d'Orléans*, known as the “garden of Québec”, which is located in the middle of the St. Lawrence River, 3 miles from Québec City. The group will enjoy an introduction to and participate in *dog sledding*

Along the way, enjoy the sights of the St. Lawrence River and the beautiful Quebec countryside

- 12:30 PM** Depart hotel by coach for transfer to Quebec Airport
- 1:15 PM** Arrive Quebec Airport - Check in at ticket counter
