We will continue to have our Magic Time where every student has time for enrichment or tutoring. Students will have an assigned class that they need to be in during Magic Time. They may not leave the building. They will have opportunities to get help/ tutoring from teachers. They could retake or make up tests and quizzes during this time. Once a week the teachers will be using Magic Time to talk about student data to help improve and make greater strides in our state tests.

We have also split up the lunches. All students will be given a 30 minute lunch. If a student wishes to move lunches, it could potentially change and impact their elective classes. Barberton City Schools does not have an open lunch policy. Students are not allowed to run out for food and bring it back for others. We will not accept any food service delivery such as; DoorDash, Grubhub, etc.

We do have one big change this year. We are asking that all students who are late or do not show up at the traditional time due to being in a compact or college credit plus will need to enter the building at the main doors. We will undergo some construction to ensure that we have a safer control of who enters our building. This will require students to walk around the building. We know this is an inconvenience but safety never is. Please be patient later in the year when we restructure the main entrance and upgrade our security

All students in CCP or are in a compact have study halls and/or Magic Time on their schedule. If a college credit plus student has the liability waiver turned in then they may leave the building when they do not have academic periods. If they choose to stay in the building then they MUST be in their study hall or Magic Time classes. The waiver does not allow them to wander around the school.

We are asking that students email their guidance counselor if they have questions or concerns.

PLEASE NOTE: school pictures will be earlier than normal. They will take place Aug 29th. We moved them up as students are able to use their school ID that comes free of charge to help them sign in and in the lunch line.

We do have a few new classes this year. We have a Drone class. Students will learn how to operate and use drones in industry. They have the potential to earn credentials which can help them enter the workforce. We have a partnership with Jobs for American Graduates that will be starting here at Barberton High School as well.
