Arrival and Dismissal

***See the traffic pattern map at the back of this letter. The traffic patterns on this map are expected to be followed when dropping-off and picking-up your student(s). There is **NO PARKING** in the loop during drop off and pick-up, cars must remain in the loop and students must remain in the car until the appropriate time (8:15am). All cars should enter the drop-off and pick-up loop from 3rd street and from the South. 2nd Street is reserved for school buses.

***Please complete the dismissal form at the back of this letter and return to your students homeroom teacher at open house so they know how your student is leaving from BIS each day. This form should match the information you entered into final forms.

Attendance

Daily school attendance is essential to student academic and social growth and achievement. The expectation is that our students are at school and on-time each day. If your student is sick or has an appointment and cannot be at school please contact the school office at 330-745-5492 and then Press #2 to make the school aware of the absence. The call off line is available 24-7, please call before 9:00 am. Students who are chronically absent, tardy, or truant will be put on an Absence Intervention Plan and will be required to attend Absence Intervention Team meetings with school administration until attendance improves.

Ohio State Testing

Starting in 3rd grade ALL students will begin taking the Ohio State Tests. Due to the Ohio 'Third Grade Reading Guarantee', students in 3rd grade will take the English/Language Arts test twice, once in the Fall, and once in the Spring. They will take the Math test in the Spring only. 4th grade students will take the English/Language Arts test and the Math test in the Spring only. 5th grade students will take the English/Language Arts test and Math test in the Spring only and will also take the Science test in the Spring. Each test is given over a two-day period as there are two parts to each test. These tests are very important for our district to assess our students' knowledge and skills related to the Ohio State Standards. It is extremely important that students give their best effort when taking the Ohio State Tests. More information about state testing will be sent home prior to the assessment days.

MAP Testing

Three times a year all 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students will participate in district growth and achievement tests called the MAP tests. MAP is one of the most trusted and innovative assessments used to measure student growth and achievement throughout the school year and from school year to school year. These tests provide teachers with accurate, actionable evidence to help inform instructional strategies that can be used to address both student strengths and weaknesses. It is extremely important that students give their best effort when taking the MAP tests. Teachers will communicate students scores and progress on their MAP tests as they are taken throughout the school year.

Cell Phones

The Barberton City Schools Policy regarding cell phones is <u>away for the day</u>. This means that although students are permitted to have them at school, they are to be stored in their lockers, bookbags, desks, or pockets throughout the day and should <u>NOT</u> be out at all during the school day. Students who do not follow this policy are subject to confiscation of their phone as well as school discipline. The BCSD is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal items.

Final Forms


Food Service
