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Is your student ready for Kindergarten?

Kindergarten registration is here! Do you know a student who will be entering kindergarten for the 2023-24 school year? Are they ready for kindergarten?

Children entering school for the first time should be developmentally supported physically, socially and emotionally.

They will experience many transitions during this time and go through many developmental changes.
They need the support from home to be successful.

Take a look at the following check points to see if your student is kindergarten ready...

Does your student have self-control?

Keep their hands to themselves?

Share and take turns?

Play with other children?

Can your student use supplies correctly?

Cut with scissors?

Hold a pencil, crayon or marker?

Build with blocks or Legos?

Can your student express selfawareness in a variety of ways?

Know their first and last name?

Write their name?

Name the letters in their name?

Can your student demonstrate selfhelp skills? Use restroom independently?

Put on their own coat and zip or button it?

Tie shoes?

Finally, is your student able to follow the directions of adults and communicate their needs?

In addition, students should be 5 by August 1, 2023. It helps to know their letters, sounds and be able to count to 20.


