## **Remote Instruction**

In order to give us a safety cushion of six days from the actual holiday-to the return of students into our building, all students will participate in remote learning from home on Monday, November 30th, Tuesday, December 1<sup>st</sup> and Wednesday, December 2nd. Students will then return to in person learning on Thursday, December 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Remote Instruction for the 3 days will be live teaching. Attendance will be taken all 3 days. Students will use their Chromebooks to get onto google classroom and then will log into their teacher's google meet at 9:30am each day. Students have practiced this with their teachers and know how to do this. Students will have a lunch break and another scheduled break throughout the day. The student's school day will officially end at 3:00pm each day.

Teachers will send out a more specific schedule for their individual classrooms for these three days ahead of time so everyone is on the same page. If you have any questions do not hesitate to contact your students teacher or the school office.
