3RD GRADE AIR TEST

All 3rd grade students will be taking the Fall English/Language Arts AIR (state) tests this month. Third graders will take part 1 on October 26th and part 2 on October 27th. We are asking that our students take their time and try their best on these assessments. Students scores will help to guide instruction throughout the year. Third graders will take this test again along with the Math AIR test in the Spring.
