Payment & Cancellation

Registration is based upon availability. For one day trips, the first \$35 of your trip payment is non-refundable, in addition to any non-refundable trip components. For multi day trips, the first \$100 of your trip payment is non-refundable, in addition to any non-refundable components. There will be no refunds issued for cancellations made within 45 days of the trip departure date. All credit and debit card payments will incur a non-refundable convenience fee of 3%, and ACH payments will be charged \$2 per transaction. There are no fees for mailing a check. Checks are to be made payable to “Nowak Tours” and mailed to 1395 Barn Run Dr, Valley City, OH 44280. Checks will not be accepted within 30 days of trip departure.

Unless otherwise shown below, these exclusions apply to You, Your Traveling Companion, or Family Member scheduled and booked to travel with You.

The following exclusion(s) apply(ies) to the Trip Cancellation and Trip Interruption. We will not pay for any loss or expense caused due to, arising or resulting from: 1. a Pre-Existing Medical Condition, as defined in the policy.
