

COVID-19 Student Testing

What: COVID-19 testing for K-12 students who are attending **in-person** classes and are symptomatic. (*Testing is for return-to-school purposes **only**, no sports eligibility, travel, etc.*) A limited number of COVID-19 tests will be administered daily.

When: Beginning August 31, 2020 ♦ Monday – Friday 1pm-3pm
By Appointment Only

Who Is Eligible:

- K-12 students currently attending in-person classes.
- Students who are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 based on observation by the school and/or parents. Symptoms may include: fever, headache, loss of taste or smell, cough, difficulty breathing, chills, fatigue, muscle/body aches, sore throat, congestion/runny nose, nausea, vomiting or diarrhea.
- The eligible student's Primary Care Physician must be contacted by the family, and all other testing options must be exhausted prior to referral to SCPH.

Process for Referring Students:

1. **Parents** can submit a request for testing, through the School Testing Referral Officer, for a child who exhibits symptoms at home during the daily symptom check or symptoms that present during the school day. All other avenues of testing the child **must** have been exhausted.
2. **School Testing Referral Officer** can make a referral to SCPH for the child by calling **(330) 926-5630 – this number is for school administrators only please do not share**. The referral must include the child's name and the parent/guardian's name & phone number.
 - **SCPH** will contact the parent/guardian to schedule an appointment for the child to be tested Monday-Friday between the hours of 1pm-3pm. *Parent/guardian **must** be present with child for testing.*
3. **Reporting Results:**
 - Positive results – a phone call by SCPH to parent/guardian
 - Negative results – email to parent/guardian.
