All families must complete a new application each year on or before September 15th.

Students will need to know their student ID number when getting breakfast and/or lunch. This number can be found by logging into Progress Book. This is a 999 number that they will also use for login purposes on their chromebook.

#### **5th Grade**

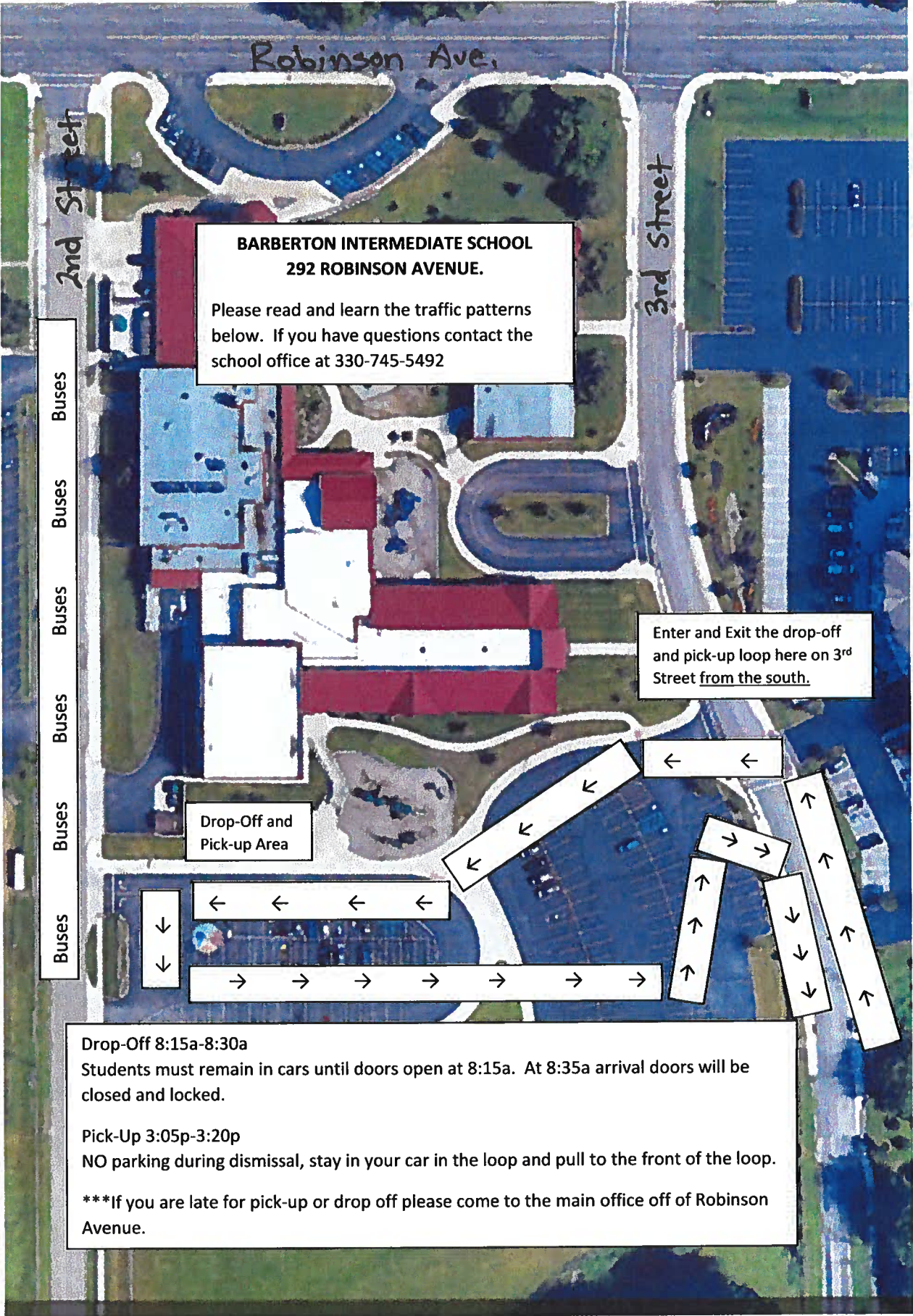

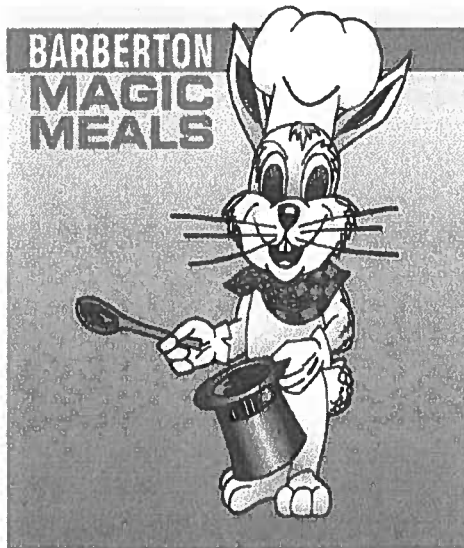
